ENSEMBLE Entry Requirements

- <u>Accelerate Ensemble</u> is for those who are either brand NEW to playing
 OR wish to CHANGE their instrument in high school. This ensemble prepares girls to join other
 ensembles. Accelerate is particularly looking for girls interested in learning a new, 'targeted' instrument
 (see Accelerate Scholarships information below).
- Year 7/8 Wind Ensemble: If you enjoyed band in primary school, you're going to love the fun and challenge of playing in the Year 7/8 Wind Ensemble. Girls are expected to stay in 7/8 Ensemble until the end of Year 8, even if they are invited to join the Senior Wind Ensemble.
- 3. <u>Senior Wind Ensemble (SWE)</u>: Usually starting in Year 9, but more experienced musicians can be *'invited'* by conductors to join the **Senior Ensemble** earlier.
- 4. <u>Chamber Ensemble</u>: If your daughter plays any string instrument at any level, she is welcome!
- 5. Jazz Ensemble: Open to anyone currently playing in one of the Wind Ensembles. Jazz/Stage Band ALSO welcomes guitarists and pianists who are NOT currently in the other ensembles.
- 6. <u>Percussion Ensemble</u> is open to all interested students no experience necessary!

WGHS School Vocal and Choir Program

There are very established vocal and choir ensembles run by the WGHS Music Department: These include:

- Combined Choir no audition necessary.
- Junior Vocal Ensemble by audition for Years 7-9.
- Senior Vocal Ensemble by audition for Years 10-12.

ACCELERATE Instrument Hire Scholarships

WGHS is proud of this new program which encourages girls to try out a new instrument. Accelerate Instrument Hire Scholarships are for 'targeted instruments' (unusual and often more expensive instruments. See list below). Scholarships cover the hire cost of the instrument for the first two years. This is a great opportunity for girls wish to challenge themselves with a new instrument in high school. HOW TO JOIN THE WGHS MUSIC PROGRAM

Sign up and follow these simple steps.

STEP 1: Register your interest: Please complete go to Eventbrite (see link. Also accessible via WGHS website). Once registered, you will be emailed updates and ensemble info.

STEP 2: Music Info Night: Thursday 4th February @7pm for new parents and students.

FEES: One ANNUAL flat membership fee of (\$700) covers your daughters' involvement in ANY or ALL music ensembles. WGHS tries to avoid collecting any extra money throughout the year! This cost covers payment of conductors' fees, purchase of sheet music, annual Intensive Band Workshop, buses where required and much more! Note: Fees for Year 7 students are NOT due until early March, so your daughter can 'try out' the ensembles before committing to the whole year.

INSTRUMENT Hire: It is expected that most girls provide their own instruments. Certain instruments may be available for hire, Subject to availability: \$250 per year (plus \$100 bond). Note: Fees are subject to review for instruments provided for hire by the Music Program, whether targeted or otherwise,

BAND TOURS: International, Regional and local – WGHS is always going places! In 2014 WGHS debuted its international Music Tour program in Hong Kong. In 2016, 58 girls toured California USA, visiting schools and colleges from San Francisco to LA, performing at exciting venues such as Disneyland! In between these major international tours, regional tours are a fun way to see our own state and have fun while performing in rural towns across NSW. The next Regional Tour is planned for June 2021 and Year 7 students are more than welcome to join!

YEAR-ROUND CALENDAR: WGHS musicians are kept busy all year round with plenty of fun gigs. From festivals to band competitions to workshops! Band rehearsals start in the second week of Term 1 followed closely by the Intensive Band Workshops (in-house band camp). Performances throughout the year are at the Sydney Opera House, Town Hall, Chatswood Concourse and Chatswood RSL and at community events such as Willoughby Spring Festival and the Northbridge Fireworks. Band competitions are held during Winter (Term 2 & 3) at UNSW and the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. (NB, all dates, events and performances TBC for 2021).
