GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- All WGHSNC registrations must be paid in full; please contact us confidentially if you require payment assistance.
- WGHSNC players who elected to use the **2021 \$25 refund as a 2022 credit** will receive a single use voucher code.
- The 2022 registration system is new, called PlayHQ.
- Both player & parent/guardian will need to set up a PlayHQ profile.
- When registering & creating your player profile please set up your/daughter's name in with Initial Caps only, ie, capital first letter only on given and last names. Eg., Jill Smith.
- The 2022 winter comp runs from April until early September 2022 no games in school holidays.
- All games are played on Saturdays at Willoughby Leisure Centre.
- All parents/guardians/carers are requested to read and acknowledge the Club's T&Cs which include a **privacy policy and codes of conduct**. The full conditions of registration will be available on WGHS website, P&C page in Week 1, Term 1.
- Your early registration is much appreciated, and there is a reduced fee for registrations made before school resumes.

ACTIVE KIDS \$100 PROGRAM

- The NSW Government provides a \$100 Active Kids voucher to parents/guardians of school enrolled children. You will receive a voucher for each child you register. Each voucher has a unique ID number which is entered at registration, in the GOVERNMENT vouchers section on the payments screen.
- Active Kids \$100 rebate can be obtained via ServiceNSW website, using your child's Medicare number. Create or login to your MyService NSW account and complete an Active Kids application.

Remember to obtain the AK voucher number BEFORE commencing the registration process.

GRADING & TEAM FORMATION

- Players in Years 7 9 will be individually graded and allocated to teams based on skill, ability and position selection.
- Grading enables players to be placed in a team with others of similar ability, who will play against other teams of a similar level. Team selection aims to give everyone a 'fair go' and the best possible experience playing netball.
- The grading process is independent and undertaken by experienced graders. In registering your daughter, you agree to accept the grading decisions of the Club.
- Attendance at grading is essential, or contact Mel @ wghsnetball@gmail.com if you have a clash.

- Based on the Health Orders & Covid Guidelines at the time, players are required to follow all Covid related regulations set out at the venue and by NSNA at all times. Further details will be communicated prior to attendance.
- Spectators are discouraged at grading.

TEAMS FOR YEARS 10-12 & X-Students ***

- Year 10 players will be able to play either competitive or social netball & nominate who they'd like to play with. However, some degree of flexibility may be required & final team formations are subject to player numbers & committee approval.
- Players in Years 10 12 & X-Students are eligible to submit full teams of 8 10 players subject to Committee approval.
- Each full team submitted must have a nominated Captain or Manager (16 years or older) to be eligible to register.
- Paper grading for these teams will be conducted based on previous team results.
- Teams and players in Years 10 12 may be required to attend a meeting in late February to finalise team placements.

Note: Yrs 10 – 12 Individual and small groups requests will be reviewed and considered. The Committee hopes to accommodate all requests received, but please be aware that due to player numbers and grading, it may not be possible to keep small groups together.

*** Any full team lists must be sent by the nominated Team Manager or Captain to: <u>wghsnetball@gmail.com</u> no later than Sunday 13 February, 2022. Please include your age in the subject line, plus 'Full Team', eg, 16s full team.

TRAINING

- All teams in Year Groups 7 12 are required to participate in one hour squad training sessions on Wednesday afternoons at either 4pm or 5pm during Terms 2 and 3, with some occasional sessions late in Term 1.

NEW PLAYERS – PROOF OF AGE

At Northern Suburbs Netball Association (NSNA) players are graded in age groups by year of birth. All new players may be required to provide a copy of their birth certificate or passport as identification and proof of age.

VOLUNTEERING

Our Committee is made up of a group of fun, like-minded, busy Mums, Dads and X-Students who are passionate about ensuring that everyone has a great Netball season. We welcome anyone and everyone who would like to join us and help do their bit for the Club. We currently have a paid administrator to help keep volunteer tasks to a minimum throughout the year.

It is a condition of Registration that a Parent/ Guardian of each registered Junior/Cadet player, or each Senior Player, will assist with Grounds Duty (or Canteen Duty) on the days allocated to the Club by NSNA if they are not already volunteering in another area of the club. NSNA Grounds Duty usually occurs once or twice a season.

Please consider how you can help out this season. We are keen to have parent team managers for each of our Year 7 - 9 teams, to assist with organisation and communications. Players are also encouraged to get involved as much as possible to continue to grow and improve our club.

JEWELLERY

- Jewellery including earrings, watches and friendship bands cannot be worn & must be removed.
- Nails must be short & smooth.
- DO NOT GET YOU/R DAUGHTERS EARS PIERCED BEFORE OR DURING THE NETBALL SEASON AS SHE/YOU WILL NOT
 BE ALLOWED TO PLAY. Earrings CANNOT be taped.

COVID UPDATE (25/1/22)

- Our Association, Northern Suburbs is committed to providing a successful 2022 season and to adjusting the competition according to the environment at the time.
- NSNA has advised that all players & umpires aged 16 years & over will be required to be double vaccinated. Information on other age groups, team members & spectators will be issued in due course.
- However, these decisions will not be ratified by the NSNA Council until Feb 8, then communicated to our members. Please contact wghsnetball@gmail.com in confidence to discuss this.

Covid safety procedures & restrictions may impact the 2022 netball season, including spectator restrictions. At this stage it's likely that all players & umpires 16 years & over must be double vaccinated- to participate. Changes will be communicated as promptly as possible.

PRIVACY & PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

WGHS P&C NC will, to the best of its ability, protect and respect your privacy and personal information at all times. Details are collected purely for the purpose of sporting registration and insurance with our parent bodies, Netball Australia, Netball NSW and NSNA.

During grading, an individual's playing history may be shared with the grading team for the purpose of team placement.

Throughout the season photographs may be shared on our official social media platforms, in club communications and end of season publications to celebrate Club achievements. IF YOU DO NOT WISH YOUR CHILD'S PHOTO TO BE PUBLISHED, PLEASE LET US KNOW by emailing <u>wghsnetball@gmail.com</u>, with the subject line DO NOT PUBLISH including your full name and your child/ren's name/s.

PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. I will play safely, fairly within the rules and spirit of the game.
- 2. I will respect the opposition, umpires and coach/es at all times.
- 3. I will follow the appropriate guidelines when requesting clarification from an Umpire.
- 4. I will speak respectfully to others at all times.
- 5. I will treat all players as I would like to be treated.
- 6. I will be a good sport, role model and always set an example.
- 7. I will thank the other team, umpires and coaches at the end of the game.
- 8. I will immediately notify a WGHS or NSNA Official on duty should any assistance be required at a game.
- 9. I will attend every game and training with a positive attitude and give myself and my team the best of my ability.
- 10. I will listen to my coaches and apply feedback to my game.
- 11. I will seek assistance and clarification if I am unsure and work with others to develop my knowledge.
- 12. I will co-operate with and be polite to my coach, manager, opposition, officials and teammates at all times.
- 13. I will be punctual and prepared for all games and training, including: nails short and smooth, no jewellery and in the correct uniform.
- 14. I will commit to attending all training and games, unless unwell. In which case I will communicate with the Coaching Convenor (wghscoach@gmail.com), Coach/es and/or Manager at least 48 hours prior.
- 15. I will NOT attend training if I feel unwell* and will notify the appropriate people as soon as possible. (*as per Covid guidelines at the time.)

PARENT/GUARDIAN/SPECTATORS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. I will attend games only under the rules set by NSNA in regards to spectator allowances.
- 2. I will attend games to support, spectate and celebrate my child/ ren and the opposition.
- 3. I will follow all Covid* related restrictions when entering the NSNA facility, including 'check in'.
- 4. I will follow all instructions of NSNA and WGHS Netball Officials.
- 5. I will ensure to engage and support respectfully with the team Coaches and Managers.
- 6. I will encourage my child and the team to play within the rules of the game and show respect to all officials.
- 7. I will be respectful, supportive, fair and courteous at all times.
- 8. I will immediately notify a WGHS or NSNA Official on duty should any assistance be required at a game.
- 9. I will accept the decision of the Club in relation to team grading and acknowledge any withdrawal of my child due to grading will forfeit the registration fee.
